We are thrilled to share our accomplishments this year in supporting the women and children of the Family Recovery Center!

We take this opportunity each year to reconnect with all of our members and supporters as we begin our 2023-2024 Membership Renewal Drive. Your past support is greatly appreciated, and we again ask for your continued support by renewing your DreamKeepers membership at this time. Your membership dues and supportive contributions have permitted us to continue to assist with the daily needs of the Family Recovery Center clients as well as providing the following during the last year:

- The life-changing Work Readiness Program continues to grow, with monthly graduations, and every FRC client in the program receiving workbooks, training, and professional attire to aid in their career development and job search.
- The enhanced Layette Program now includes strollers, car seats, breast pump equipment, co-sleeper bassinets, baby gates, and humidifiers, in addition to key essentials for new FRC moms and their newborns in a diaper bag backpack.
- The thriving Joan Jacobson Garden Project continues to provide a bounty of produce for the FRC kitchen, as well as an opportunity for the clients to learn skills and appreciate spending time outdoors in the refurbished garden setting.
- Continued to provide for everyday needs for FRC clients and children, including newspaper subscriptions; a reusable DreamKeepers water bottle for new clients; organizer agendas for all new clients for scheduling their meetings, court dates, classes, and childcare obligations; and ice cream parties for summer holidays.
- Co-Sponsored the FRC Welcome Party for the state-wide *Tour de Recovery* Bike Ride to raise awareness of mental health issues, substance abuse and recovery, and to raise scholarship funds for deserving graduates of Mental Health Systems/FRC.
- Through generous grants and anonymous donations, several other large projects were installed, including a large sail shade for the playground, three washers and three dryers for client usage, and new outdoor patio furniture for the garden and atrium.
- Membership funds will also be used for bedroom renovation costs over and above the 2023 Mother's Day Appeal donations to complete this major project.
